High Street, Merthyr Tydfil (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading) (Revocation) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 23rd July 1976 the Mid Glamorgan County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to revoke the existing provisions prohibiting the loading and unloading of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.15 a.m.; 12.30 p.m. and 2.15 p.m.; and 4 p.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive, in respect of the Orders specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto in so far as they relate to the lengths of roads referred to in Column 2 of the said Schedule.

The Order came into operation on the 23rd July 1976, and a copy thereof and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected at the offices of the Mid Glamorgan County Council, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours until the end of 6 weeks from the 23rd July 1976.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, as so amended, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation

to the Order, may, within 6 weeks from 23rd July 1976, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
