#### HALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Halton Borough Council (Hale Road/Ditchfield Road/St. Michaels Road) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976.*

Notice is hereby given that the Halton Borough Council, as agents for the Cheshire County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which would be:

1. To revoke the Order specified in Column 1 to the extents specified respectively in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this notice;
2. To prohibit, with certain exceptions, the waiting of vehicles in the lengths specified in Column 2 of the roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice.

The Order would contain exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, maintenance of essential services, building and roadworks, the delivery or collection of postal packets and for disabled persons to park their vehicles.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the lengths of roads to which it relates together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the Municipal Building, Kingsway, Widnes. Objections to the proposed Order together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 30th August 1976.

##### Lengths of roads in the Borough of Halton

Ditchfield Road (north side)	From its junction with Hale Road in a westerly direction for approximately 81 metres to its junction with Canterbury Road.
Ditchfield Road (south side)	From its junction with Hale Road in a westerly direction for approximately 101 metres to its junction with Arnold Place.
St. Michael's Road (both sides)	From its junction with Hale Road in a south-easterly direction for approximately 70 metres. (790)

#### HALTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

*The Halton Borough Council (Cooper Street and Midland Street, Widnes) (Revocation and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Halton Borough Council, as Agents for the Cheshire County Council, propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 28(1), 28A(5) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (a) To revoke the Borough of Widnes (Parking Places and Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1970, insofar as it relates to Cooper Street and Midland Street Widnes;
- (b) To permit waiting in the lengths specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Notice of the roads specified in column 1 of the Schedule on such days and during such hours as specified in column 3 of the Schedule respectively;
- (c) To prohibit waiting in the lengths as specified in column 5 of the Schedule to this Notice of the roads specified in column 1 of the Schedule on such days and during such hours as specified in column 4 of the Schedule respectively.

The proposals only change the existing situation insofar as they relate to the north side of Cooper Street and the south side of Midland Street. Whereas at present, limited waiting of one hour in any two is permitted on those lengths of road from within a distance of 14 metres of the junctions with Albert Road, if the proposed Order is made then limited waiting will only be permitted on the same lengths road within a distance of 60 metres of those junctions. Thus, there would be no waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday (inclusive) on those sides of Cooper Street and Midland Street for a distance of 60 metres west of the junctions with Albert Road.

The remaining existing provisions will be unaltered by the proposed Order and will be re-enacted. However, the Council do propose to prohibit loading and unloading on the south side of Cooper Street and the north side of Midland Street between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday (inclusive) for a distance of 45 metres from the junctions with Albert Road. These proposals will be contained in a separate Order and are subject to a separate Public Notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions to the limitations on waiting time and the prohibition of waiting outlined in (b) and (c) above for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading and unloading, maintenance of essential services, building and roadworks, the delivery and collection of postal packets and for disabled persons to park their vehicles.

A copy of the proposed Order and a map showing the roads to which it relates together with Statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the Municipal Building, Kingsway, Widnes. Any objections to any of the new proposals which change the existing situation must be sent, in writing, to the undersigned by 30th August, 1976.
