PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

THE CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

*The Portsmouth No. 3 Smoke Control Order 1976
ORDER 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act on the 27th July 1976, made an Order entitled "The Portsmouth No. 3 Smoke

Control Order 1976" declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Bedfordshire (Mill Lane, Sandy)
(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1976*
