TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under S.209 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping Up of Highways (County of Northumberland) (No. 9) Order 1976" authorising the stopping up of lengths of Delaval Terrace, Wanley Street and back Delaval Terrace/Bowes Street, Blyth, Northumberland.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 12th August 1976 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

- (1) An Order under S.209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of lengths of New Street and Market Street, Braintree to enable development consisting of shops, offices and formation of service area on land on the east side of New Street and north side of Market Street, Braintree to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Crossman Investments Ltd by Braintree and Bocking Urban District Council.
