ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BRIGHTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Brighton (Albion Hill/Newark Place) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th August 1976 the Brighton Borough Council, acting as Agents for the East Sussex County Council, made the above Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 13th September 1976 will be to prohibit waiting at all times as follows:

- (A) on the north-east side of Albion Hill, from 30 feet north-west of Newark Place to 45 feet south-east of Newark Place; and
- (B) on both sides of Newark Place, from Albion Hill for 45 feet.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

- (a) picking up and setting down of passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading goods; and, where necessary, in connection with:
- (c) the maintenance of the roads; and also for
- (d) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads affected may be examined at the Enquiry Office, Town Hall, Brighton, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, or, on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the 5th August 1976 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
