2. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the west side of Sandy Lane, Skelmersdale, from its junction with High Street for a distance of 90 metres in a northerly direction.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as is necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road, or the services therein or if the vehicle is a Disablied person's Vehicle.

The Order will come into operation on the 30th August

1976.
