DROUGHT ACT 1976

River Blithe: Reduction of Compensation Water

Notice is hereby given that, because of exceptional shortage of rain, the South Staffordshire Waterworks Company are applying to the Secretary of State for the Environment for an Order under section 1 of the Drought Act 1976. Under the provisions of the South Staffordshire Waterworks Act 1939 the Company are required to discharge from their Blithfield reservoir into the river Blithe at a point not more than two hundred yards below the foot of the embankment of the reservoir not less than five million gallons of water per day in a regular, uniform and continuous flow.

The general effect of the proposed Order would be to reduce for a period of six months from the making of the Order or until the water in the Blithfield reservoir had reached top water level, whichever first occurred, the daily quantity of water required to be discharged into the river Blithe from five million gallons to two million gallons.

A map on which is indicated the site at which the above-mentioned water is discharged may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period of seven days from the date of the publication of this notice at the offices of the Company at 50 Sheepcote Street, Birmingham, B16 8AR, and at the Engineer's Office, Blithfield Reservoir, Abbot's Bromley, near Rugeley, Staffordshire.
