Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of:

(a) picking up and setting down of passengers;(b) loading and unloading goods;

and, where necessary, in connection with:

(c) the maintenance of the roads; and also

(d) the supply of gas, water and electricity; and
(e) disabled persons' vehicles bearing the appropriate
disabled person's badge, which will be allowed to wait
for periods of up to two hours, return prohibited

within one hour.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Enquiry Office, Town Hall, Brighton, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.
