The County of Devon (Plymstock Road/Dean Cross Junction, Plymstock) (Prescribed Route) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th August 1976, the Devon County Council made the above Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into force on the 17th August 1976, every person causing any vehicle to proceed in an easterly direction along Plymstock Road, Plymstock in the City of Plymouth, shall cause that vehicle, on reaching the junction of Plymstock Road with Dean Cross, to make a left-hand turn into Dean Cross Road.

The Order will not apply to buses operating on scheduled services.

The County of Devon (The Broadway, Plymstock) (Experimental Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th August 1976, the Devon County Council made the above Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

When this Order comes into effect on the 17th August 1976, you will not be allowed to drive a vehicle in that length of road known as The Broadway, Plymstock in the City of Plymouth, between its junction with Dean Hill and its junction with Horn Lane, for an experimental period of 6 months.

The Order will not apply to vehicles being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes.

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dorset (Shore Road, Swanage) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on 9th August 1976 the Dorset County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended

by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into operation on 13th August 1976 no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in either direction in that length of Shore Road, Swanage in the Purbeck District from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Victoria Avenue, during the period ending 30th September 1976.

The restrictions imposed above shall not apply to:

1. the loading and unloading of goods vehicles at premises in this section of road between the hours of 6 p.m. and 11 a.m. during the said period;
2. emergency service vehicles;
3. statutory undertakers vehicles;
4. post office vehicles;
5. vehicles engaged in street works and street cleaning;
6. vehicles engaged in building or demolition works;
7. vehicles engaged in removing obstructions;
8. invalid carriage (i.e. a mechanically propelled vehicle not exceeding 5 cwt. unladen specially designed and constructed for the use of a person suffering from some physical defect or disability and used solely by such a person).
