The effect of the Direction is as follows:

The permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973-1974 shall not apply to the development of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto of the said land, and any such development shall not be undertaken except upon the grant of planning permission by the Local Planning Authority or the Secretary of State for the Environment upon an application in that behalf.

This Direction is effective from the date hereof and shall remain in force for 6 months unless, before the termination of the said 6 months, it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
