notice will be extended to include the times between

(d) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle in the carriageway and lengths of streets referred to in paragraph 3 (a) above will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises edicent to the ately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(e) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, in the carriageway and lengths of streets referred to in paragraph 3 (a) above

will be prohibited.

4. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 3 (a) and (b) above will not apply in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
