

Copies of the Order may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the ground that any requirement of that section of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

If the provisions of the Order continue in operation for a period of not less than 12 months and have not at any time been varied or suspended under section 9 of the Act of 1967, the Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order

under section 6 of the said Act of 1967. Any person desiring to object to the making of the Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1967 for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation in force may, within the aforementioned period of 12 months send a statement in writing of his objection and the grounds thereof to the Director of Planning and Transportation, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB, quoting the reference PT/TD/C.
