## DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (County of Dorset) (No. SW6) Order 1976" extinguishing any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on parts

of Shaftesbury Road, Canford Road, Kingston Road, St. Mary's Road, and St. John's Road, Poole, Dorset.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the 19th August 1976 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

Any person who, at the time of the coming into force of the Order, has an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates shall be entitled to be compensated by the Poole Borough Council as the local planning authority in respect of any depreciation in the value of his interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable.

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971
