#### SCHEDULE 1

##### *Length of road in the Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley*

Un-named access road leading in a northerly direction from Queens Foad at a point opposite Bootham Terrace.

#### SCHEDULE 2

##### *Sides of road in the Metropolitan Borough of Barnsley Queens Road*

North side from its junction with the western side of Carey Avenue to its junction with the eastern side of the un-named access road opposite Bootham Terrace (in Schedule 1).

South side from its junction with the western kerb line of Windermere Road to its junction with the eastern kerb line of the slip road from the Eastern Relief Road.

*Windermere Road*—west side from its junction with the southern kerb-line of Queens Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction. (655)

#### SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*South Yorkshire County Council (Various Streets, Goldthorpe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1976.*

Notice is hereby given that on the 12 August 1976 the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 20th September 1976 will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles:

- (i) at any time in either of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (ii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, the supply of gas, water and electricity, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets.

A further exception will permit waiting by a vehicle which displays the relevant disabled person's parking badge for a period of up to two hours, return prohibited within one hour.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads the subject of the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, Brierley Hall, Brierley, near Barnsley and (ii) Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, Town Hall, Goldthorpe.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 12th August 1976 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### SCHEDULE 1

Sides of road in Goldthorpe in the Metropolitan District of Barnsley

##### *King Street*

South side, from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Gosling Gate Road to its junction with the western kerb line of Whitworth Street.

##### *Whitworth Street*

West side, from its junction with the southern kerb line of King Street for a distance of 17 metres in a southerly direction.

#### SCHEDULE 2

##### (i) *Kelly Street*

West side, from its junction with Mason Street in a southerly direction to a point 32 metres north of its junction with the northern kerb line of Barnsley Road.

##### (ii) *Barnsley Road*

North side, from its junction with the western kerb line of Whitworth Street for a distance of 44 metres in a westerly direction.

##### (iii) *Whitworth Street*

West side, from its junction with the northern kerb line of Barnsley Road for a distance of 22 metres in a northerly direction. (656)

#### SOUTH YORKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*South Yorkshire County Council (Orchard Lane, Beighton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1976*

Notice is hereby given that on the 12th August 1976 the South Yorkshire County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The effect of the Order which will come into operation on the 20th September 1976, will be to prohibit waiting by vehicles:

- (i) at all times in any of the sides of road referred to in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (ii) between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions to the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, in connection with building, industrial or demolition operations, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and for the collection and delivery of postal packets.

A further exception will permit waiting by a vehicle which displays the relevant disabled person's parking badge for a period of up to two hours, return prohibited within one hour.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the road the subject of the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, Brierley Hall, Brierley, near Barnsley and (ii) the Sheffield City Council, 2-12 Division Street, Sheffield.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 12th August 1976 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### SCHEDULE 1

Sides of road at Beighton in the Metropolitan District of Sheffield

##### *Orchard Lane*

North-east side from its junction with the southern kerb line of West Street to a point 15 metres south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Cooks Road.

South-west side from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Allen Street for a distance of 25 metres in a south-easterly direction.

##### *Cooks Road*

From its junction with the north-eastern kerb line of Orchard Lane for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

#### SCHEDULE 2

##### *Orchard Lane*

South-west side from a point 25 metres south-east of its junction with the eastern kerb line of Allen Road to a point 40 metres south-east of its junction with the southern kerb line of Cross Allen Road.
