2 The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Newham (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1971, so that

(a) in the length of Bendish Road specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice the hours during which the existing pro-

hibition applies on-

(i) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or un-loading a vehicle) would be changed so as to apply at any time;

(ii) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be changed so as to apply between 11

a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week;
