## HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

*The London—Tilbury Trunk Road (Mar Dyke to East of Grays Section and Slip Roads) Order 1976*

*The London—Tilbury Trunk Road (Mar Dyke to East of Grays Section and Slip Roads Side Roads) Order 1976*

The Secretary of State for the Environment hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 7 and 44 of the Highways Act 1959 and section 68 of the Highways Act 1971 providing that a road which he proposes to construct at Grays, Thurrock in the county of Essex shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation;

2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959, sections 3 and 62 of the Highways Act 1971 and other enabling powers authorising him:

- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
- (ii) to stop up highways;
- (iii) to construct new highways;
- (iv) to stop up private means of access to premises;
- (v) to provide new means of access to premises,

all at Grays, Thurrock aforesaid and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Essex as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Copies of the Orders and of the relevant plans have been deposited at the Department of the Environment, Room P2/038, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB, and the Department's Eastern Road Construction Unit, 59-63 Goldington Road, Bedford, MK40 3LY, and at the offices of Essex County Council, County Hall, Chelmsford; Thurrock Borough Council, Whitehall Lane, Grays, Essex; Aveley Sub-Post Office, 104 High Street, South Ockendon; North Stifford Sub-Post Office, 7 Browns Cottages, North Stifford; Thurrock Central Library, Orsett Road, Grays; Chadwell St. Mary Branch Library, Brentwood Road, Grays and Blackshots Branch Library, Blackshots Lane, Grays.

Copies of the Order, the title of which is "The London—Tilbury Trunk Road (Mar Dyke to East of Grays Section and Slip Roads) Order 1976" (S.I. 1976 No. 1292) can be purchased price 12p through booksellers or direct from government bookshops (H.M.S.O.). Any person aggrieved by the Orders or by either of them and desiring to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that they or either of them are not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of either of those Acts, or of regulations made thereunder, has not been complied with in relation to both or either of the Orders, may within six weeks from 24th August 1976, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or Orders in question or of any provision contained therein.

## WAGES COUNCIL

## EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION ACT 1975

*Ostrich and Fancy Feather and Artificial Flower Wages  
Council (Great Britain)*

The Ostrich and Fancy Feather and Artificial Flower Wages Council (Great Britain) hereby gives notice of proposals for (1) varying the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Ostrich and Fancy Feather and Artificial Flower) Order 1975 (Order OF (55)); (2) amending the provisions relating to holidays and holiday remuneration set out in the Wages Regulation (Ostrich and Fancy Feather and Artificial Flower) (Holidays) Order 1975 (Order OF (56)); and (3) the revocation of Order OF (55) and Order OF (56).

The Wages Council intends that the revised provisions shall come into operation on 24th September 1976.

Particulars of the proposals are contained in the Wages Council's Notice OF (57) copies of which may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below. The Wages Council will consider any written representation with respect to the proposals if made within 14 days from 24th August 1976. Any such representation should bear the writer's address and signature and be sent to the Secretary, Ostrich and Fancy Feather and Artificial Flower Wages Council (Great Britain), 12 St. James's Square, London, SW1Y 4LL. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections and quote the number of the Wages Council's Notice of Proposals OF (57).
