

of paragraph (f) of section B of Part III thereof there were substituted the following:

1. The rate at which the licence holder may abstract water from the source of supply mentioned at provision (a) above (hereinafter called "the abstraction") shall be subject to the following provisions:

(1) The sum of the abstraction at Rhadyr and the abstraction near to Llanddetty Hall shall be the sum of—

(i) the regulation release, and  
(ii) when the difference between the flow per day of the River Usk as measured at the commencement of any flow day of twenty-four hours at Trostre and the regulation release is either:

(a) not exceeding 30,000,000 gallons per day, an amount not exceeding 14,000,000 gallons per day; or

(b) in excess of 30,000,000 gallons per day and not exceeding 100,000,000 gallons per day an amount not exceeding the sum of 14,000,000 gallons per day and 60 per cent. of the amount by which the said difference exceeds 30,000,000 gallons per day, or

(c) in excess of 100,000,000 gallons per day and not exceeding 150,000,000 gallons per day, an amount not exceeding the sum of 56,000,000 gallons per day and 40 per cent. of the amount by which the said difference exceeds 100,000,000 gallons per day, or

(d) in excess of 150,000,000 gallons per day, an amount not exceeding the sum of 76,000,000 gallons per day and 20 per cent. of the amount by which the said difference exceeds 150,000,000 gallons per day';

9. Abstract water by means of pumps and any associated works from the Pontnewynydd Springs (National Grid Reference SO 276 018) at a rate not exceeding 750,000 gallons per day under the terms of the Licence Serial Number 20/56/12/55 granted under the Water Resources Act 1963 at all times as though no minimum prescribed flow was specified for the Afon Lwyd in the Licence;

10. Abstract water by means of pumps and any associated works from the northern shore of the Lake known as Llyn-y-Fan Fawr (at National Grid Reference SN 830 218) a quantity not exceeding 10,000,000 gallons per day which may be discharged into the River Trinant, at or near the source of the said river (at National Grid reference SN 829 223) the waters of which eventually flow into the River Usk. A quantity of water equal to that abstracted and discharged may be abstracted by the Authority through their Rhadyr Intakes on the River Usk in addition to any other water they are entitled to abstract through that intake;

11. Abstract water by means of pumps and any associated works from the Bwllfa Lake at the Aberdare Country Park (at National Grid reference SN 9762 0282) at a rate not exceeding 600,000 gallons per day;

12. Abstract water by means of pumps and any associated works from the Nant Ffrwd stream at Ynyssybwl at a point adjacent to the footbridge over the Nant Ffrwd on the public footpath from the Kissing Gate at Bethel Chapel to Mynachdy Farm (at National Grid reference ST 0499 9475) at a rate not exceeding 400,000 gallons per day; and

13. Abstract water by means of pumps and any associated works from the Nant Amman Fawr immediately downstream of the junction with the Nant Amman Fach (at National Grid reference SS 9963 9949) at a rate not exceeding 150,000 gallons per day.

The various parcels of land required for use and occupation under paragraphs 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 hereof are more particularly described in the maps hereinafter mentioned.

#### WELSH NATIONAL WATER DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

##### *Drought Act 1976*

Whereas Licence Serial No. 22/61/6/1/4 together with section 5 of the Pembroke Rural Water Order, 1958 which relate to the abstraction of water from the stream that flows under Stem Bridge in the Community of Castlemartin in the district of South Pembrokeshire provide that a prescribed flow of water of not less than 100,000 gallons per day shall flow in the said stream immediately below the intake situated at Grid Reference SN 931 987 about ten yards downstream of the said bridge.

Notice is hereby given that because of an exceptional shortage of rain, a serious deficiency of supplies of water exist in the area of the West Wales Water Division of the Welsh National Water Development Authority, and that the Authority, pursuant to powers contained in section 1 of the Drought Act 1976 is about to apply to the Secretary of State for Wales for an Order, the general effect of which would be that for a period not exceeding three months the prescribed flow shall be reduced to 20,000 gallons per day.

#### WELSH NATIONAL WATER DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

##### *Drought Act 1976*

Whereas: (1) Licence Serial Nos. 22/61/4/1/4 and 5 provide that not less than 400,000 gallons per day of compensation water shall be discharged from Prescelly Rosebush Reservoir into the Afon Syfynwy, and

(2) Licence Serial No. 22/61/4/3/4 together with section 4 (2) of The Prescelly Water Order 1957 provides that 4 million gallons of water per day may be abstracted from the River Eastern Cleddau at Pont Hywel, Grid Reference SN 129 274 subject to a prescribed flow in the river of 1 m.g.d.
