

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County Council of West Sussex, East Grinstead—
Traffic Regulation*

Notice is hereby given that the West Sussex County Council propose to make two Orders under the provisions of section 1 and section 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the first of which will be entitled "The County Council of West Sussex (East Grinstead: Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1976". The effect of this Order will be:

To alter the existing waiting restrictions, or to impose new restrictions in certain lengths of the following roads in East Grinstead, so as to prohibit waiting at all times in those lengths of road:

To alter the existing waiting restrictions, or to impose new waiting restrictions in certain lengths of the following roads in East Grinstead, so as to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. every day of the week in those lengths of road:

London Road	Railway Approach
Station Road	Queens Road
Orchard Way	Park Road
High Street	Brooklands Way

To alter the existing waiting restrictions, or to impose new waiting restrictions in certain lengths of the following roads in East Grinstead, so as to prohibit waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of road:

Imberhome Lane	De La Warr Road
St. James's Road	Portland Road
Christopher Road	Garland Road
Church Lane	Queens Road
Imberhome Way	Cantelupe Road
Dallaway Gardens	Orchard Way

To alter the existing waiting restrictions, or to impose new waiting restrictions in certain lengths of the following roads in East Grinstead, so as to limit waiting to one hour, return prohibited within one hour, between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of road:

High Street	Little King Street
Imberhome Lane	Railway Approach
Portland Road	Ship Street

Queen's Road	

To consolidate the existing waiting restrictions in East Grinstead which are not affected by the proposals, including the prohibition of loading and unloading in the High Street and the existing one-way traffic Orders, into this new Order.

To make Church Lane, East Grinstead, two-way between the southern kerbline at its junction with St. Swithin's Close to the entrance to the car park at the northern end of the road.

To prohibit any vehicle proceeding in London Road, East Grinstead, from making a right hand turn into Queen's Road.

The Second Order which it is proposed to make would be entitled "The County Council of West Sussex (East

Grinstead: Various Roads) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 2) Order, 1976". This Order is proposed in conjunction with the construction of the Inner Relief Road and would be introduced when the new road is opened. Its effects would be:

To prohibit waiting at all times along the Inner Relief Road, East Grinstead.

To alter some of the waiting restrictions described above and to impose some further waiting restrictions so as to prohibit waiting at all times in certain lengths of the following roads in East Grinstead:

London Road	Tower Close
Moat Road	Station Road
St. James's Road	Park Road
Fairfield Road	Brooklands Way
Lewes Road	Old Road
Railway Approach	

To limit waiting to one hour, return prohibited within one hour between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in a length of Brooklands Way in East Grinstead.

To prohibit vehicles from proceeding in the following lengths of road in East Grinstead in a direction other than that stated opposite to the length of road:

(i) London Road from the north-west side of the central island which is to be constructed at its junction with Station Road, south-eastwards to its junction with the westbound approach road which is to be constructed to the Inner Relief Road.

South-eastwards.

(ii) The westbound approach road which is to be constructed to the Inner Relief Road and which will link London Road to the Inner Relief Road.

North-westwards.

(iii) The slip road which is to be constructed and which will join London Road to the new westbound approach road.

Southwards.

(iv) The eastbound approach road which is to be constructed to the Inner Relief Road and which will link London Road with the Inner Relief Road.

Eastwards.

(v) The Inner Relief Road, from its junction with the eastern end of the eastbound approach road which is to be constructed, to its junction with Station Road.

Westwards.

(vi) Station Road, from its junction with the Inner Relief Road, to its junction with London Road.

North-eastwards.

(vii) Railway Approach, from its junction with London Road, to its eastern most junction with the loop road which is to be constructed on the southern side of Railway Approach.

Westwards.

(viii) The loop road which is to be constructed on the southern side of Railway Approach.

Clockwise direction.

(ix) St. James's Road, from its junction with London Road, south-westwards for a distance of 14 metres.

North-eastwards.

The usual exceptions will be provided in both of the Orders.

Copies of the proposed Orders, together with plans showing the affected lengths of road, and a statement of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders, may be inspected at the County Hall, Chichester, during normal office hours or at the Public Library, Southwick House, London Road, East Grinstead, during normal library opening hours.
