Hyde Park Estate and St. Marylebone South Controlled Parking Zone

Notice is hereby given that, on the application of the Council of the City of Westminster, The Greater London Council on 18th August 1976 made the City of Westminster (Parking Places) (No. 11) Order 1976 under sections 35, 36, 37, 40 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968.

- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to revoke the designation of certain charged-for parking places in controlled parking zones and to create a new controlled parking zone, comprising the streets and parts of streets listed in Schedules 1 and 4 to this Notice, wherein charged-for metered and residents' parking places will be designated.
 - The Order will—
 - (a) revoke the designation by the Order listed in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Notice of the parking place allocated the number specified in column 2 of that Schedule and which is situated on the highway specified in column 3 of that Schedule:
 - The date of revocation of the designation of the parking places is specified in relation thereto in column 4 of the said Schedule.)
 - (b) designate parking places on the highways specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice at which charges may be made by the City Council for vehicles authorised by the Order to be left in those parking places;
 - (c) provide that the type of parking place, the maximum initial period, the rate of charge and the date on which the charges in respect of that parking place will come into operation will be as set out in the heading to each Part of the said Schedule 3 in relation to the highways specified in that Part;
 - (d) provide that the excess charge and the excess period in respect of all metered parking places will be £4 and 1 hour respectively and will come into operation on the same dates as the charges set out in the said Schedule 3;
 - (e) provide that the parking places will operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.30 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. on Saturdays (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);

 - (f) provide that the vehicles which may be left—
 (i) in a metered parking place shall be passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motor cycles and invalid carriages;
 - (ii) in a residents' parking place shall be those displaying a parking card bearing the letter "F" issued by the City Council;
 - (g) provide that parking cards will be issued by the City Council on application being made by any person residing in the streets and parts of the streets listed in Schedules 1 and 4 to this Notice who is the owner of a passenger vehicle (12 seats or less), a goods carrying vehicle not more than 8 feet in height, a motor cycle or an invalid carriage;

 - (h) specify that in the residents' parking places—
 (i) the payment of the daily charge is by the purchase of a parking token from the City Council and by the affixing of that token to the calendar combined with a valid permit (heretofore referred to as a parking card) within the space thereon appropriate to the date on which the vehicle is left in the parking place and the parking card must be displayed on the vehicle. If the vehicle displays a valid permit combined with a valid season ticket (also heretofore referred to as a parking card) no such charge is payable;

 (ii) the charge for season tickets is £7.50 or £27 for tickets expiring at the end of 3 months and 12 months respectively
 - running from the beginning of the month in which they are issued;
 - (i) provide that any unexpired time shown on a parking meter may be used free of charge and the period during which a vehicle may not return to a metered parking place is 1 hour;
 - (j) provide that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes) and vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no
 - (k) provide that the City Council shall withdraw from any person who is a resident of any street or part of street listed in Schedule 4 to this Notice any permit combined with a season ticket issued under the provisions of the City of Westminster (Parking Places) Order 1968 which will cease to be valid on the date on which the Order becomes fully operative; the City Council will serve a specific notice on each person who is affected;
 - (1) provide that the City Council shall issue without charge to a resident of any street or part of street listed in Schedule 4 to this Notice from whom a permit combined with a season ticket is to be withdrawn in pursuance of sub-paragraph (k) above another permit combined with a season ticket issued under the provisions of this Order which will be valid for the period which remained unexpired at the time the first permit combined with a season ticket was withdrawn;
 - (m) amend the City of Westminster (Parking Places) Order 1968 so that a person who qualifies as a resident under the provisions of that Order, will not be permitted to leave his vehicle in the residents' parking places in the streets or part of streets listed in Schedule 4 to this Notice.
- 4. The restrictions imposed by the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 will apply to any areas previously designated as parking places and not redesignated as such, as it applies in the immediate vicinity.
- 5. The Order will come into operation for the purposes of the applications for parking cards and for the installation of parking meters, etc., on 30th August 1976 and for all other purposes in relation to the parking places on the highways specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice on the dates specified in relation thereto in the heading to the relevant Part of that Schedule.
- 6. A copy of the Order, of the Parking Places (St. Marylebone and Westminster) Order 1965, of the City of Westminster (Parking Places) Order 1968 and of the City of Westminster (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1976 (and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied any of those Orders) and of the map which indicates each length of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has
