The Camden (Prescribed Routes) (No.) Traffic Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to revoke and re-enact (with modifications) part of the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Holborn) Regulations, 1960 and The London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Holborn, St. Marylebone, St. Pancras and Westminster) Regulations, 1961 so as to restore two-way working for vehicular traffic in the south-western arm of Bedford Square, between its junction with Adeline Place and a point opposite the north-western wall of No. 34 Bedford Square.

3. Exemption would be provided in the Order in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the above-mentioned Regulations of 1960 and 1961 and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until 20th September 1976 in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

The Bromley (Prescribed Route) (No. 2) Experimental Traffic Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Greater London Council, on 20th August 1976 made the above-mentioned Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicles from turning right from Manor Road, Beckenham into Wickham Road.

Exemption has been provided in the Order in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
