

(g) the unnamed street extending from the rear of premises numbered 10 Heber Street to the rear of premises numbered 64 Blackburn Street.

(ii) To revoke the Borough of Radcliffe (Traffic Regulation) (No. 2) Order 1967.

Exceptions are included in the Order to allow vehicles access from Blackburn Street to the other roads specified in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph 1, for the purpose of:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers at premises situated on or adjacent to the other roads;
- (b) loading and unloading goods at premises situated on or adjacent to the other roads;
- (c) the exercise of statutory powers and duties including the maintenance of the other roads and the supply of gas, water and electricity; and
- (d) funeral services.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the road affected may be inspected at the office of the Director of Administration, Town Hall, Bury, during normal working hours.

The Order will come into effect on the 11th November 1976.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for this purpose.
