WILTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967

The County of Wiltshire (College Road Area, Trowbridge) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 25th August 1976, the Wiltshire County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to restrict waiting on lengths of road in the vicinity of Trowbridge Technical College as follows:

Prohibition of Waiting at all times on lengths of Almond Grove, Beech Grove, Chestnut Grove, College Road, Service Road to property numbers 2 to 54 College Road, Laburnum Grove, Lilac Grove, Willow Grove and Silver Street Lane (at junctions with Willow Grove and Frome Road).

Waiting limited to 1 hour with return prohibited within 1 hour on Monday to Friday between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. on lengths of Beech Grove, College Road, Laburnum Grove, Lilac Grove, Silver Street Lane and Willow Grove.

Waiting limited to 1 hour with return prohibited within 1 hour on Monday to Friday between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on lengths of Willow Grove and the lay-by on the north side of the Service Road to property Nos. 2 to 54 College Road.

Exemptions are made in the Order to enable a person to load or unload goods or to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

Exemptions also apply to any disabled person's vehicle to wait on the lengths of road referred to above in accordance with regulations.

A copy of the Order and plan may be inspected at the County Solicitor and Clerk's Office (Environment Division), County Hall, Trowbridge, during normal office hours.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C or any regulation made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made make application for the purpose to the High Court.

The Order will be operative as from the 7th September 1976.
