*The Trunk Road (The London "D" Ring Road) (A1-A111 Section) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 197*

The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the London "D" Ring Road (A1-A111 Section).

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the main carriageways on the length of the London "D" Ring Road which extends from its junction with the A1 Trunk Road at South Mimms Roundabout to its junction with A111 Southgate Road, Potters Bar, a total distance of approximately 2½ miles.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to stop if it is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein.

*The Trunk Road (Marsh, Devon) (No Right Turn and One Way Traffic) Order 1976*

The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, on that length of the London—Penzance Trunk Road (A303) at Marsh, in the District of East Devon in the county of Devon.

The effect of the Order, is to:

- (i) prohibit westbound traffic on the newly constructed Marsh Diversion from turning right into A303 at the western end of the diversion;
- (ii) prohibit traffic from travelling other than in a north-easterly direction on that length of A303 from its junction with the Marsh Diversion for a distance of 87 metres north-eastwards.

The alternative route for affected traffic will be via the recently constructed junction on the Marsh Diversion.
