The Queen has been graciously pleased to approve the following award:

Queen's Commendation for Valuable Service in the Air T4272489 Flight Sergeant Edward Henry Berry, Royal Air Force.

For his courage, skill and tenacity when, as helicopter winchman, he made four descents in adverse weather to rescue two men, a woman and a child from a small boat pitching violently in a very rough sea. The boat was attached by a line to an anchored yacht moving erratically about its anchor, with its mast and rigging presenting a constant hazard during the rescue operation, which was nevertheless completed satisfactorily.
