The Trunk Roads (Various Roads, Aberystwyth) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, which shall come into operation on 10th December 1976. The effect of the Order will be:

- (a) to prohibit the waiting, loading and unloading of any vehicle on either of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle in any of the lengths of road or on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (c) to restrict the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day, other than a Sunday, to 1 hour in any period of 2 hours on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 3 to this notice.

The Order revokes the following Orders:

- (i) The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Aberystwyth) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1965;
  (ii) The County of Cardigan (Various Streets, Aberystwyth) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1966 (insofar as it relates to Mill Street and Alexandra Road);
- (iii) The County of Cardigan (Alexandra Road);
   (iv) The County of Waiting) Order 1973; and
   (iv) The County of Dyfed (Various Roads, Aberystwyth) (Experimental Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)
