The Middlesbrough No. 27 (Albert Park) Smoke Control Order, 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Middlesbrough Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act, 1956, on the 22nd day of December 1976, made an Order entitled 'The Middlesbrough No. 27 (Albert Park) Smoke Control Order, 1976, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Smoke Control Area, which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the Smoke Control Area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence, and liable to a fine not exceeding £20 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st July 1979 or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Borough Secretary's Office, Municipal Buildings, Middlesbrough, Cleveland, at all reasonable times during the period 6 weeks from 6th January 1977.
