ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The Trunk Road (Cemmaes Road, Powys) (40 m.p.h.
Speed Limit) Order 197*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 74 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit the driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 m.p.h. in the length of road specified in the Schedule below.

This Order will replace the Trunk Road (Cemmaes Road) (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1976.
