BROMLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The London Borough of Bromley No. 29 Smoke Control Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Bromley London Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the above-mentioned Act, on the 6th January 1977, made an Order entitled The London Borough of Bromley No. 29 Smoke Control Order 1976, declaring the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a smoke control area which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

Subject to the limitations and exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act if, on any day after the Order has come into operation, smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building within the smoke control area, the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

Copies of the Order and of the map referred to therein may be inspected free of charge at the Town Hall, Bromley, Kent, at all reasonable times during the period of 6 weeks from 20th January 1977.

If it is confirmed the Order will not come into operation before the first day of November 1977, or before a later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London, SW1P 3EB object to the confirmation of the Order.

SCHEDULE

All that piece or parcel of land (with the buildings thereon) within the London Borough of Bromley and bounded on the north by a line along the centre of Station Road and High Street, Orpington; the east by a line along the centre of Court Road Orpington-by-Pass from the High Street in the north to a point opposite the eastern boundary of 398 Court Road to the south; the south by a line along the east boundary of 398 Court Road; by a line along the rear boundaries of houses in Court Road to the rear boundary of No. 1 The Highway; by a line along the rear boundaries of Nos. 1-89 The Highway; by a line along the south-west boundary of 89 The Highway to the centre of The Highway; by a line in a south-westerly direction along the centre of The Highway to its junction with the Goddington Ward boundary in Warren Road, thence westwards to the railway line; and the west by that part of the Chelsfield/Orpington railway line situated between Warren Road in the south and Station Road in the north.
