- Highway Avenue *East side* from its junction with Bath Road northwards to a point approximately 15 metres north of its junction with Mariborough Road.
 - West side from its junction with Bath Road northwards for a distance of approximately 53 metres and from its junction with Marlborough Road northwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres and southwards for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

(a) To introduce no waiting at any time in the under-mentioned lengths of road and parts of lengths of road in the City of Birmingham:

Bradford Street, Barford Street, Bishop Street, Cheap-side, Dean Street, Gloucester Street, Hurst Street, Pershore Street, Rea Street, Rea Street South, Smithfield Passage, Sherlock Street, Upper Dean Street.

(b) To introduce no waiting Monday to Saturday between 7.30 and 6.30 p.m. in further

(c) To inforduce its waiting Monday to Saturday between
7.30 and 6.30 p.m. in further parts of Rea Street
and Rea Street South in the City of Birmingham.
(c) To permit waiting for one hour in two in further
parts of Bishop Street and Hurst Street on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday in the City of Birmingham.

This Order for waiting restrictions contains an exemption in respect of the loading and unloading of goods in the lengths of road set out above.

(d) This Order revokes the City of Birmingham (One Way Traffic) (No. 20) Order 1975, The City of Birming-ham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 10) Order 1967, The City of Birmingham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 32) Order 1968, The City of Birmingham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 34) Order 1968, part of The City of Birmingham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 9) Order 1967 and The City of Birmingham (Traffic Regulation) (No. 11) Order 1968.

(ii) The City of Birmingham District Council (Markets Area) (One Way Traffic) Order, 1977

To introduce one-way traffic in the undermentioned lengths of road in the City of Birmingham in the direction specified to that length of road.
