*The County of Devon (James Street, Plymouth)
(Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1976*

Notice is hereby given that on the 14th January 1977 the Devon County Council made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is:—

To prohibit the driving of motor vehicles from:

- (i) North Road East to Cobourg Street; or
- (ii) Cobourg Street to North Road East along James Street in the City of Plymouth.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the roads to which the Order relates may be inspected during normal office hours at the address given below.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the 14th January 1977 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into force on the 14th January 1977.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Devon County Council (Axe Bridge, Seaton)
(Weight Restriction) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that on the 10th January 1977 the Devon County Council made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Order which comes into effect on the 18th January 1977 will prevent all track laying vehicles and all vehicles, whether laden or unladen, with an axle weight which exceeds 7 tons, from proceeding in that length of Harbour Road, Seaton (B.3172) which crosses Axe Bridge and extends from a point 154 metres east of Trevelyan Road eastwards for 46 metres. Public service vehicles are exempt.

The Order and a map showing the affected road may be seen during usual office hours, Monday to Friday, at Room 3.33 Civic Centre, Exeter and at the East Devon District Council Offices, Majowa, Fore Street, Seaton.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not yet been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 14th January 1977 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dorset (Various Streets, Bridport)
(Traffic Regulation) Order 1977*

Notice is hereby given that on 10th January 1977 the Dorset County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effects of this Order which comes into operation on 14th January 1977 will be:

- (1) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the following lengths of road in Bridport:

- (a) *North Street* (both sides)—from its junction with West Street to the property known as St. Hilda's.
- (b) *Rax Lane* (both sides)—for its entire length.
- (c) *Chards Mead Road* (both sides)—from its junction with Victoria Grove to its junction with Rax Lane.

- (2) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. on the following length of road in Bridport:

North Street (both sides)—between the property known as St. Hilda's and its junction with Victoria Grove.

- (3) To restrict the driving of vehicles to southbound traffic only on that section of North Street from its junction with Rax Lane to its junction with West Street.

The restrictions imposed in (1) and (2) above shall not apply to:

- (a) picking up and setting down passengers,
- (b) loading and unloading goods,
- (c) disabled persons vehicles bearing the relevant badge issued by a local authority;

and, where necessary, in connection with:

- (d) the maintenance of the roads, and
- (e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

A copy of the Order and a plan showing the lengths of road affected are available for inspection during normal office hours Monday to Friday at:

- (1) Dorset County Council, Transportation and Engineering Department, County Hall, Dorchester, Dorset.
- (2) West Dorset District Council, Area Office, Mountfield, Bridport, Dorset.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date hereunder apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DUDLEY METROPOLITAN BOROUGH

The Borough of Dudley (Park Street, Chapel Street, and Hanbury Hill, Stourbridge) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1977.

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Dudley acting pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the county Council of West Midlands, propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to revoke the limited waiting in Park Street, Chapel Street and Hanbury Hill, Stourbridge, imposed by an existing Order;
- (b) to extend the lengths of prohibited waiting in Park Street and Chapel Street, Stourbridge, imposed by an existing Order.

The Order will include exemptions for picking up and setting down passengers, for loading and unloading goods, for vehicles being used in the service of a local authority, the Post Office or statutory undertakers in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, for vehicles being used in connection with weddings and funerals and for disabled persons' vehicles.

A copy of the draft Order, the map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Council House, Dudley, during office hours.
