Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to amend the Neath Traffic Order made on 17th March 1976 as follows:

- 1. Windsor Road. 4. The Ropewalk (Windsor Road to Dark Arch Section). To amend the existing Order so that the only restriction on the north side will be limited waiting for 1 hour in any 2 hours, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday on a length of the road outside the houses near Dark Arch.

 Ropewalk Lane. To prohibit waiting 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Saturday in respect of both sides of the lane from the junction with the Ropewalk for its entire

Exemptions will be provided in the Order where appropriate for essential services, loading and unloading facilities,

and disabled drivers' vehicles etc.
