The Trunk Road (Station Road and Pevensey Road, Polegate) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977

The Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 on the Folkestone - Brighton - Southampton - Dorchester - Honiton Trunk Road (A.27) in the district of Wealden in the county of East Sussex.

The effect of the Order, which comes into operation on 24th January 1977, is to prohibit waiting at any time on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice, and to restrict waiting on the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice to between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday for a period not

exceeding one hour in any two.

Exceptions have been provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to operation or demolitors, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein. There is also a provision exempting disabled persons' vehicles which displays in the relevant prescribed position a disabled person's (orange coloured) badge.

Any person agrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provisions contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the

above Acts, or on the ground that any requirement of those Acts, or of regulations made there under, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from 17th January 1977, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or any provision con-

tained therein.

tion with Fairlight Close to a point 120 feet southeast of its junction with Fairlight Close.

(2) Station Road and Pevensey Road:

North side, from a point 240 feet south-east of its junction with Western Avenue to a point 600 feet south-east of its junction with Western Avenue;

North side, from a point 615 feet south-east of its junction with Western Avenue to a point 665 feet southeast of the same junction;

North side, from a point 680 feet south-east of its junction with Western Avenue to a point 45 feet east of its junction with Dover Road;

The London-Portsmouth Trunk Road (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 197

The Secretary of State for Transport proposes to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be:

1. to prohibit waiting on any of those main carriage-ways verges or hard shoulders forming part of the London-Postsmouth Trunk Road (A3) known as the Esher By-pass in the county of Surrey which extends from a point 40 yards west of the Hook Interchange to its junction with Seven Hills Road; and

to prohibit waiting by any vehicle for the purpose of trading unless the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle, on any verge, hard shoulder or lay-by adjacent to the said main

carriageway.

The prohibition imposed by the Order will not apply:

(a) to a vehicle waiting upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden;

(b) so as to prevent a vehicle from being used in con-nection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or of any of the services therein;

(c) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or

police purposes;

(d) to a vehicle being used by or on behalf of a local authority for the purpose of collecting household refuse

or clearing cesspools;
(e) to a vehicle while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait elsewhere; and

(f) to a vehicle waiting in any case where the person in control of the vehicle:

(i) is required by law to stop;

(ii) is obliged to stop to avoid an accident; or

(iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control and cannot remove the vehicle from the main carriageway.
