NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDERS TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971 SECTION 210

The District of North West Leicestershire Diversion of Footpaths (M.74 and M.76 Peggs Green) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that on the 11th January 1977, the North West Leicestershire District Council confirmed the above named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is:

- To divert the public right of way M.74 running from its junction with the western corner of O.S. Parcel 1567 in an easterly direction for a distance of 80 metres or thereabouts to its junction with the car park off Zion Hill opposite the "New Inn" as shown on Leicester Ordnance Survey Sheet Nos. SK 4017 and 4117 to a line running from the aforesaid junction with O.S. Parcel 1567 in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 70 metres or thereabouts and thence in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 28 metres or thereabouts and thence in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres or thereabouts to join Zion Hill.
- To divert the public right of way M.76 running from its junction with the boundaries of O.S. Parcels 1454 and 1567 in a north-easterly direction for a distance of

76 metres or thereabouts to its junction with the car park off Zion Hill opposite the "New Inn" as shown on Leicester Ordnance Survey Sheet Nos. SK 4017 and 4117 to a line running from the aforesaid junction with the boundaries of O.S. Parcels 1454 and 1567 in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 38 metres or thereabouts and thence in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 58 metres or thereabouts to join the aforesaid car park.

The District of North West Leicestershire Diversion of Footpath (0.97 Ashby-de-la-Zouch) Order 1975.

On the 11th January 1977, the North West Leicestershire District Council confirmed the above named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed, is to divert the public right of way (path 0.97) from a point 55 metres or thereabouts from its junction with Packington Road, Ashby-de-la-Zouch (point A) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 254 metres or thereabouts to its junction with the railway line (point D) as shown on Leicester Ordnance Survey Sheet Nos. 3515/3516 (A-D) to a line running from the aforesaid point A in an easterly direction for a distance of 38 metres or thereabouts to point B and thence in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 224 metres or thereabouts to point C and thence in a northerly direction for a distance of 24 metres or thereabouts to the aforesaid point D (A-B-C-D).

The District of North West Leicestershire Stopping-Up of Footpath (L.68 Kegworth) (Part) Order 1976.

On the 11th January 1977, the North West Leicestershire District Council confirmed the above named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed, is to extinguish the public rights of way running from the junction with footpath L.67 at the southern end of Pleasant Place in an easterly direction for a distance of 36 metres or thereabouts and from the aforesaid junction with footpath L.67 in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 65 metres or thereabouts to its junction with Whatton Road.

Copies of the confirmed Orders and maps annexed thereto have been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Municipal Offices, London Road, Coalville, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays.

These Orders become operative as from the date on which it is certified by the North West Leicestershire District Council that the provisions of Article 2 of the Orders have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by any Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Orders, he may under section 244 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, within 6 weeks from the 21st January 1977, make application for this purpose to the High Court.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1971 SECTION 210

The Leominster District Council (Bodenham) Public Path Diversion Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the above named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on the 13th January 1977 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Leominster District Council as an unopposed Order. The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the existing public footpath numbered B.M.11 on the Definitive Map running from its junction with the Class III Road (number 125) leading from Sutton St. Nicholas to England's Gate in the County of Hereford and Worcester in a westerly direction for a distance of 123 metres or thereabouts to a new line commencing at the eastern end of the length of public footpath to be diverted and ending at the western end of the length of public footpath to be diverted.
