(2) will prohibit parking between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays (inclusive) on the following roads and sides of lengths of roads in the Welwyn area:

London Road: on both sides from its junction with Prospect Place in a southerly direction for a distance of 183 metres.

School Lane: on both sides from the junction with High Street in a westerly direction to the west flank wall of No. 4 School Lane.

The Green: on both sides of The Green from its junction with School Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.

Prospect Place: on both sides from the junction with High Street/London Road in an easterly direction to the east flank wall of No. 28 Prospect Place.

Hertford Road: On both sides from its junction
