

2. The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972, so that in Bride Lane, the hours during which the existing prohibition applies

(a) on waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be changed so that it will apply at any time;

(b) on waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be changed so that it will apply between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week.

3. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 28th January 1977, and of the City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1972 (and of the Orders which have previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

4. Copies of the Order may be purchased from the Information Centre, Greater London Council, The County Hall, London, SE1 7PB.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
