The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Conwy) (One-Way Traffic) Order 197

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be to revoke and re-enact with amendments the present trunk road one-way traffic system in Conwy. The proposed Order, as re-enacted, will make the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this notice one-way in the direction specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
