Royal County of Berkshire (Kings Road, Windsor) (Residents Parking Places and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 28(1) and 31(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is to:

1. Prohibit waiting on the lengths of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice between the hours of 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. on Mondays to Sundays inclusive, unless the driver displays on the vehicle a permit issued to a resident whose property is in the lengths of road specified in the above mentioned Schedule.

Royal County of Berkshire (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) (Hermitage) Order, 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 the effect of which is to:

1. Revoke the Royal County of Berkshire (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order 1962 insofar as it relates to the Newbury—Hampstead Norreys Road (B.4009), which extends from a point approximately 116 metres southwest of Priors Court Road junction to a point approximately 250 metres north of Yattendon Road junction, a distance of approximately 1,127 metres.
