The Trunk Road (Llanbadarn Fawr, Dyfed) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State proposes to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle; to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; to enable a vehicle to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein; or to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

An exception will also be provided in the Order to enable a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position both a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the length of road referred to in the Schedule to this Notice for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).

A copy of the proposed order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of the Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Aberystwyth.

Objections to the proposed Order should be sent to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff, CF4 5PL not later than 21st February 1977, quoting the reference WR15/2/71, stating the grounds of objection.

That length of the Newton—Aberystwyth Trunk Road (A.44) at Llanbadarn Fawr in the County of Dyfed which extends from its junction with Penyfron Road in a general south-easterly direction to a point 45 yards south-east of its junction with the Ponterwyd—Devil's Bridge—Aberystwyth Road (A.4120).
