

## SOUTH GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

*New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan*

Notice is hereby given that on the 25th January 1977 the County Council of South Glamorgan in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act 1972 and the Road Traffic Act 1974 made Orders the general effect of which is to impose traffic regulations on the roads listed in Column 1 of the Schedule below. The nature of the restriction is shown in Column 2.

The Orders will come into effect on the 29th January 1977 and their titles are shown in Column 3. Copies of the Orders and Maps showing the restricted areas are available at the address shown below where they may be examined during normal office hours.

<b>Canton Area</b>		
(a) on both sides of Lionel Road from its junction with Cowbridge Road East for a distance of 10 metres north.	Prohibition of waiting at any time.	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Lionel Road, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.
(b) on the east-side of Lionel Road from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Cowbridge Road East to its junction with Loftus Lane.	Prohibition of waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday.	
<b>Grangetown Area</b>		
(a) on both sides of Clarence Embankment from its junction with Clarence Road for a distance of 35 metres in a south westerly direction.	Prohibition of waiting at any time.	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Clarence Embankment, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.
(b) on the south east side of Clarence Embankment from a point 35 metres south west of its junction with Clarence Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south westerly direction.	Prohibition of waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Friday.	
(c) Clive Lane East at its junction with Stockland Street Paget Lane West at its junction with Stockland Street.	Prohibition of driving (the lanes will be closed by bollards at this junction).	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Clive Lane East/Paget Lane West, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1977.
(d) Llanbradach Street Aber Street Taff Terrace.	2 ton weight restriction (except for access).	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Llanbradach Street/Aber Street/Taff Terrace, Cardiff) (Weight Restriction) Order 1977.
<b>Splott Area</b>		
(a) on the north west side of Pearl Street from a point 47.5 metres north east of its junction with Clifton Street for a distance of 40 metres north east.	Prohibition of waiting at any time.	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Pearl Street, Splott, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.
(b) on the south side of Pearl Street from a point 47.5 metres north east of its junction with Clifton Street to its junction with Splott Road.	Prohibition of waiting at any time.	The County Council of South Glamorgan (Pearl Street, Splott, Cardiff) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977.

If you wish to question the validity of any of the Orders or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from the 25th January 1977 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

## GLOUCESTER CITY COUNCIL

*The City of Gloucester (Byron Avenue/Shakespeare Avenue) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucester City Council (being a District Council for the purposes of the Local Government Act 1972), exercising the undermentioned powers of the Gloucestershire County Council under arrangements made pursuant to section 101 of the said Local Government Act 1972, propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at all times in certain lengths of the following roads:

Byron Avenue  
Shakespeare Avenue

Exceptions are contained in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, or for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic and the maintenance of any of the lengths of road or the services therein. An exception is also provided for

the vehicle used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties. A further exception is provided in the case of a disabled person's vehicle.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order, which together with a map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be seen at the office of the City Planning Officer and Engineer, Cedar House, 8 Spa Road, Gloucester or the Guildhall, Gloucester, on Mondays to Fridays, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposed Order, stating the grounds on which they are made, should be sent in writing to the City Planning Officer and Engineer at Cedar House, 8 Spa Road, Gloucester, GL1 1XW, by not later than 28 days from the publication of this notice.
