

1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972.

The effect of the Order is to revoke the existing Orders, and to re-introduce some of the restrictions contained in the said Orders and to introduce some additional restrictions.

When the Order comes into effect:

- (a) you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle on part of the following roads in Caernarfon:

- (b) You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on part of the following roads in Caernarfon:

- (c) You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from the 1st May to the 30th September in any year (both dates inclusive) on part of the following roads in Caernarfon:

 St. Helens Road.

- (d) You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle for a longer period than 20 minutes, return prohibited for 2 hours, in part of the following roads:

Castle Square (Y Maes) (B.4419).

- (e) You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle for a longer period than 40 minutes, return prohibited for 2 hours in part of the following road:

Bank Quay.

- (f) You will not be allowed to drive your vehicle along the following roads other than in the direction specified in the Order:

Exceptions to the restrictions contained in Paragraph 3 (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) above will permit waiting:

- (i) for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers and, where necessary, in connection with:
 (ii) the maintenance of the roads; and
 (iii) the supply of gas, electricity and water; and
 (iv) where the vehicle is a disabled persons vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge such a vehicle may wait in that part of the road referred to in paragraphs 3 (d) and (e) above and may wait for a period of up to 2 hours in that part of the roads referred to in paragraph 3 (a), (b) and (c) above, return prohibited for an hour. This exemption will not apply, however, to that part of the roads referred to in (v) below between 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m.; and
 (v) for the purpose of loading and unloading goods. You will not, however, be allowed to wait in order to load or unload goods, other than postal packets, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. in part of the following roads:
 Llanberis Road (A.4086)—known for part of its length as "Pool Lane".
 Little Pool Street.

The Order will come into effect on the 14th February 1977.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date hereof, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Halton Borough Council (Mersey View Road (Part), Widnes) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Halton Borough Council, as agents for the Cheshire County Council, propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on both sides of Mersey View Road, Widnes, from its junction with Hale Gate Road for a distance of 55 metres in an easterly direction.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, maintenance of essential services, delivery and collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of
