*The Borough of Warrington (Town Hall Drives)
(Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1976*

Notice is hereby given that the Council have made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which is to restrict waiting on the East, West and South drives of the Town Hall during the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on 7 days a week.

The Order will come into operation on 31st January 1977, and a copy of the Order and a map showing the restriction is available at the Borough Secretary's Department, Town Hall, Warrington, during the usual office hours, Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from the date of this notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1967
(AS AMENDED)*The Warwickshire County Council (Cottage Lane, Shuttery)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order, 1977*

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden) at all times on the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 1 to this notice and between the hours of 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. daily on the length of road mentioned in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down of passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the office of the County Secretary, Shire Hall, Warwick, and at the office of the Secretary, Stratford-on-Avon District Council, Council Offices, Birmingham Road, Stratford-upon-Avon, on Mondays to Fridays, during normal office hours.

Objections to the proposals, which must be in writing and must specify the grounds on which they are made, must be sent so as to be received by the undersigned by the 18th February 1977.

SCHEDULE 1

Prohibition of Waiting at any time

(i) Both sides, from its junction with Church Lane, south-eastwards and thence north-westwards for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

(ii) North-east side, from a point 100 metres from its junction with Church Lane north-westwards for a distance of approximately 149 metres.

(iii) Both sides from a point approximately 249 metres from its junction with Church Lane north-westwards for a distance of approximately 46 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Prohibition of waiting 9 a.m.—6 p.m. daily

South-west side, from a point 100 metres from its junction with Church Lane, north-westwards for a distance of approximately 149 metres.

(AS AMENDED)*The Warwickshire County Council (Various Roads, Leamington Spa)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting)
Order, 1977.*

Notice is hereby given that the Warwickshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles (except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden) in St. Helen's Road and Tachbrook Road, Leamington Spa as mentioned in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the County Secretary's Department, Shire Hall, Warwick and at the Secretary and Solicitor's Department, Town Hall, Leamington Spa on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, during normal office hours.

SCHEDULE

*Waiting to be prohibited at all times*1. *St. Helen's Road*

Both sides, from its junction with Tachbrook Road eastwards for 15 metres (replacing existing limited waiting 2 hours in 4 hours, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays inclusive).

2. *Tachbrook Road*

(1) East side, from the end of the existing prohibition south of Tachbrook Street, southwards for a distance of approximately 173 metres to join up with the existing prohibition north of Windmill Road.

(2) West side, from its junction with Cashmore Avenue, southwards for a distance of approximately 220 metres to join up with the existing prohibition opposite the junction with Windmill Road.

Waiting to be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive

St. Helen's Road

North side, from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Tachbrook Road, eastwards for 122 metres (replacing 38 metres limited waiting, 2 hours in 4 hours, 8 a.m.—6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays).

WAVENEY DISTRICT COUNCIL

*The District of Waveney (Caldecott Road, Lowestoft)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976*

Notice is hereby given that on the 27th January 1977 the Waveney District Council, acting as agent for Suffolk County Council, made the above-named Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended.

When the Order comes into effect you will not be permitted to leave your vehicle at any time on any day in the following lengths of Caldecott Road, Lowestoft:

(a) North side for its full length from the Commodore Road junction to the west kerbline of the north-south section of Caldecott Road.

(b) South side from the junction with the north-south section of Caldecott Road for 25 metres eastwards.

(c) South side for 10 metres on each side of the junction with Swonnell's Walk.

(d) South side from a point 190 metres from the west end for 150 metres eastwards.

(e) North-south section on both sides for 20 metres southwards from the north kerbline of the east-west section of Caldecott Road.
