HIGHWAYS ACTS, 1959 TO 1971

The Chester-Bangor Trunk Road and The Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (Hawarden By-Pass and Slip Roads) Order, 197 and The Chester-Bangor Trunk Road and The Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (Hawarden By-Pass and Slip Roads Side Roads) Order, 197.

The Secretary of State for Wales gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 providing:

(a) that roads which he proposes to construct at Hawarden in the County of Clwyd shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation and

(b) that the lengths of the Chester-Bangor Trunk Road and the Dolgellau-South of Birkenhead Trunk Road to be superseded by the construction of the roads described in (a) above shall cease to be trunk roads as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Clwyd (who will become the highway authority responsible for those lengths) that the new trunk roads are open for through traffic; and

2. An Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him at Hawarden aforesaid:

(a) to improve, raise, lower, or otherwise alter highways;
(b) to stop up highways;
(c) to construct new highways;
(d) to stop up private means of access to premises;
(e) to provide new means of access to premises; and
(f) to provide for the temporary diversion of highways; and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Clwyd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 10th February 1977 to 16th May 1977 at the Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff; and at the offices of Clwyd County Council, Shire Hall, Mold, Clwyd; and Alyn and Deeside District Council, Council Offices, Glynne Way, Hawarden.
