The QUEEN has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto the Cheshire County Council Her Majesty's Royal Licence and Authority that they may bear and use in their Corporate capacity for the Police Committee of the said Council and for the Cheshire Constabulary on seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms certain Arms and Crest which were granted and assigned and a Device or Badge which was exemplified unto the Cheshire Police Authority and the Cheshire Constabulary on the 10th December 1965 under the hands and seals of Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms, the said Arms, Crest and Badge to be first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in Her Majesty's College of Arms otherwise the said Royal Licence and Permission to be void and of none effect.
