The South Yorkshire County Council (Albion Road and William Street, Rotherham) (Residents' Parking Places) Order, 1977

The South Yorkshire County Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Prohibition of Waiting and Prohibition of Driving) Order, 1977

Notice is hereby given that the South Yorkshire County Council propose to make two Orders under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) and under Sections 28 and 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act, 1974.

The general effect of the proposed Orders will be-

- (a) To authorise the use of each of the parts of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this notice as a parking place between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays being public holidays excepted) in such positions as are specified in relation to that road in the said Schedule 1 of such classes of vehicle also so specified as displays a valid permit issued upon application to the South Yorkshire County Council.
- (b) To prohibit waiting by vehicles at all times in any of the sides of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.
- (c) To prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in either of the roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice PROVIDED that this prohibition shall not apply to vehicles requiring access to premises situate on either of the said roads.

The proposals are that only persons whose usual residence is at premises the postal address of which is in Albion Road or William Street at Rotherham will be eligible for the issue of a permit. Full details of the requirements and conditions relating to the application for and the use of permits and the use of parking places are set out in the appropriate Order.

Exceptions to the prohibition at paragraph (b) of this notice will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading and unloading goods, to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of obstructions to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the services therein and in pursuance of statutory powers or duties. In addition a disabled person's vehicle displaying the relevant disabled person's badges will be allowed to wait for up to two hours, return prohibited within one hour.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Orders which together with maps showing the roads to which the proposed Orders relate and statements of the County Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be examined during normal office hours at the offices of (i) the County Council, County Engineers' Department, Regent Street, Barnsley (third floor) and (ii) the Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council, Civic Building, Frederick Street, Rotherham.

Parts of road authorised to be used as street parking places

ALBION ROAD: north west side from a point 22.9 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Wellgate to a point 3 metres south west of its junction with the south western kerb line of William Street.

WILLIAM STREET: south west side from a point 2 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerb line of Albion Road to its north west end. North east side from its south east end for a distance of 37 metres in a north westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 1

Position in which vehicles may wait

Wholly within the limits of the parking place as marked on the carriageway by broken white lines conforming either to diagram 1030 or to diagram 1032 in Schedule 2 to the 1975 Regulations and parallel to the kerb with the nearside of the vehicle adjacent to the edge of the carriageway.

Classes of vehicles

Passenger vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, goods vehicle not exceeding 30 cwt. unladen weight, invalid carriage and motor cycle.
