- 1. to prohibit waiting on any of those main carriageways including any slip-roads forming part of the Exeter—Bodmin and London—Penzance Trunk Roads (A.30) which are specified in the Schedule hereto; and
- 2. to prohibit waiting by any vehicle for the purposes of trading, unless the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle, on any verge or lay-by adjacent to the said main carriageway, including any slip-roads.

The prohibition imposed by the Order will not apply:

- (a) to a vehicle waiting upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden ;
- (b) so as to prevent a vehicle from being used in con-nection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance

of the road or of any of the services therein;
(c) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
(d) to a vehicle being used for the purpose of delivery or

collecting postal packets;
(e) to a vehicle being used by or on behalf of a local authority or a water authority for the purpose of collecting household refuse or clearing cesspools;

- (f) to a vehicle waiting while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait elsewhere; and
- (g) to a vehicle waiting in any case where the person in control of it:

(i) is required by law to stop;

(ii) is obliged to stop to avoid an accident, or

- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.
- 3. to revoke the Exeter—Bodmin Trunk Road (A.30) (Bolventor to Cardinham Downs) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Clearways) Order 1977 which imposed restrictions as in 1 and 2 above from Bolventor to Cardinham Downs.
