The Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (Holywell Bypass and Slip Roads) Order 197
and

The Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (Holywell Bypass and Slip Roads Side Roads) Order 197

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of the Highways Act 1959 which will

(a) provide that roads which he proposes to construct along the following routes shall become trunk roads as from the date when the Order comes into operation

(i) a route (the main route) about 8.62 kilometres in length at Holywell in the county of Clwyd between Llwybr-hir and Pwll-melyn Farm, near Dolphin and
(ii) routes for slip roads to connect the main route with existing routes at Llwybr-hir, Pant-y-Wacco and Pwll-melyn Farm, and

(b) provide that the two lengths of the Chester—Bangor Trunk Road (A55) between Llwybr-hir and Pant-y-Wacco and Pant-y-Wacco and Pwll-melyn Farm to be superseded by the new trunk road on the main route mentioned above shall cease to be trunk roads, and shall be classified as classified and principal roads, respectively, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Clwyd (who will become the highway authority responsible for those lengths) that the said new trunk road is open for through traffic; and

2. an Order under section 9 of the Highways Act 1959 authorising him

(a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
(b) to stop up highways,
(c) to construct new highways,

(d) to stop up private means of access to premises,
(e) to provide new means of access to premises, and
(f) to carry out the temporary diversion of highways to enable highways to be realigned over or under the new trunk road;

on or in the vicinity of the route of the new trunk road on the main route mentioned above and providing for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Clwyd as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.
