The County of Dorset (Various Roads, Corfe Castle) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect:

(a) the existing traffic Orders listed below will be revoked and the provisions therein will now be incorporated in this one Order.

The County of Dorset (The Square, East Street and West Street, Corfe Castle) (Prohibition of Waiting)

Order 1966.

The County of Dorset (East Street, Corfe Castle)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968.

The County of Dorset (The Square and West Street,

Corfe Castle) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1971.

The County of Dorset (East Street and West Street, Corfe Castle) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1972.

(b) waiting will be prohibited at all times on the undermentioned lengths of road in Corfe Castle:

The Square, on its northern side between its junction with the eastern side of the road leading to the Castle entrance and a point 8 yards east of that junction.

The Square, on the whole of the south side thereof. East Street, on its eastern side between a point 17 yards north of its junction with the northern side of Station Road and a point 168 yards south of that junction.

East Street, on its western side between a point opposite its junction with the northern side of Station Road and a point 168 yards south of that junction.

West Street, on both sides between its junction with

the Square and a point 23 yards south of that junc-

West Street, on both sides between a point 85 yards south of its junction with the Square and a point 15 yards south of its junction with the northern side of the road leading to the Cemetery (a distance of approximately 196 yards).

(c) waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. during the period 1st May to 15th October in each year on the undermentioned lengths of road in Corfe Castle:

East Street, on both sides between a point 168 yards south of its junction with the northern side of Station Road and a point 343 yards south of that junction.

West Street

(i) on its western side between a point 23 yards south of its junction with the Square and a point 85 yards south of that junction;

(ii) on its eastern side between a point 23 yards south of its junction with The Square and a point

65 yards south of that junction;

(iii) on both sides between a point 15 yards south of its junction with the northern side of the road leading to the Cemetery and a point 52 yards south of the southern side of the southern access to the car park.

(d) waiting will be prohibited between the hours of 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. for longer than 1 hour in any two hours on the undermentioned lengths of road in Corfe

The Square, on its northern side between points 8 yards and 31 yards east of its junction with the eastern

side of the road leading to the Castle.

West Street (eastern side) between points 73 yards and 85 yards south of its junction with The Square.

Exceptions will permit waiting for:

(a) picking up and setting down passengers;
(b) loading and unloading goods;
(c) disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant badge issued by a local authority

and where necessary, in connection with:

(d) the maintenance of the road, and

(e) the supply of gas, electricity and water.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the undermentioned offices during normal office hours Monday to Friday:
