Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police propose to make an Order the effect of which will be as follows:

To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following length of road:

B3401 *Newbridge Village* on both sides from Clay Lane to Bank Farm Cottage a distance of 600 feet in a westerly direction.

1. To revoke the County Council of Isle of Wight (Godshill) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1975.

2. To re-enact the provisions contained in that Order together with the following additional restrictions:

(a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Newport Road (A.3020) on both sides from a point 50 feet north to a point 50 feet east of West Street (Whitwell Road).

West Street on both sides from Newport Road (A.3020) to a point 50 feet west thereof.

(b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time between 1st May and 30th September in each year in the following length of road:

Church Hollow on both sides from a point 100 feet west to a point 200 feet west of A.3020 at The Square.

(c) To limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. between 1st May and 30th September in each year in the following length of road:

A.3020 at The Square on west side from Church Hollow to a point 80 feet south thereof.

Chatfield Road on both sides from a point 45 feet west to a point 45 feet east of Allotment Road

Newport Road on both sides from Lacey's Lane to a point 250 feet south thereof

(b) To limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any hour between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. between 1st May and 30th September in each year in the following length of road:

Institute Hill on east side from a point 50 feet south to a point 100 feet south of Blackgang Road.

ISLWYN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Islwyn Borough Council (Newport-Brynmawr Road) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977

Notice is hereby given that the Islwyn Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Gwent County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle at any time as follows:

(1) *Gladstone Street* (A.4048)

North side from a point 35 metres west of the western kerbline of Woodward Road to the junction of the A.467 and to continue the prohibition around the radius and along the new section of A.467 for a distance of 30 metres.

(2) *Woodward Road*

West side for a distance of 15 metres;
East side for a distance of 22 metres.
