

to a bona fide resident living in any of the streets within the controlled area free of charge and will be valid for one calendar year. Permits will be renewed on application annually. The issue of a residents' parking permit to a resident will permit the resident to park his car during the prescribed hours at any residents' parking space within the whole area, except spaces prescribed for Meadow Road permit holders. As explained above the resident will not require the permit to park outside the prescribed hours.

Residents' permits will indicate the area and year for which they are valid and will also show the registration number of the vehicle for which they are issued, and will not be transferable to other vehicles. Whenever a resident changes his vehicle, a new permit will be issued in exchange for any existing permit.

Residents' parking spaces and all other parking spaces will be clearly marked on the roads with white lines and all vehicles parked in any parking place will have to park entirely within a parking space.

Exceptions will be permitted for a vehicle to wait at any time, whether or not as a parking space, subject to any other separate restrictions, if it is:

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers ;
- (b) waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading goods ;
- (c) a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes ;
- (d) waiting only for an obstruction to traffic to be removed ;

- (e) in the service of or employed by the Post Office ;
- (f) waiting in connection with any funeral, building operation, road-works, work undertaken by Statutory Undertakers, or furniture removal.

The 2 hour limited waiting period applying at parking places other than those reserved for residents during the daytime, will not apply to invalid carriages or vehicles displaying disabled drivers or disabled persons' badges.

The Order comes into operation on the 13th March 1977. A copy of the sealed Order, a statement of reasons and a plan showing the lengths of road affected may be inspected during normal office hours at my office at County Hall, West Bridgford, Nottingham, or at the office of the Director of Administration, Broxtowe District Council, Town Hall, Foster Avenue, Beeston, Nottinghamshire.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, not later than the 31st March 1977, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SHEPWAY DISTRICT COUNCIL

The District of Shepway (Parking Places) Order, 1977

Notice is hereby given that on the 4th March, 1977 the Shepway District Council, acting on behalf of and with the consent of the Kent County Council, made the above-named Order under Sections 31(1) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to amend and extend certain provisions of the Shepway District Council (Parking Places) Order, 1976 as follows:

- (i) to increase the charges in respect of the car parks described in the Schedule hereto.
- (ii) to provide for the closure of the Bouverie Island Multi-Storey Car Park, Folkestone between 6 p.m. and 8 a.m. the following day.
- (iii) to increase the "excess charge" from £1 to £2. The charge will be reduced to 50p if paid to a Parking Supervisor in attendance at the car park.
- (iv) to revoke the Shepway District Council (Parking Places) Order, 1976 and to re-enact the provisions thereof amended as above.

Copies of the Order, which will come into operation on the 1st April, 1977 may be inspected at any time during normal office hours at the Secretary and Solicitor's Department, Civic Centre, Folkestone or in the County Secretary's Department, Room 1.97, County Hall, Maidstone, Kent.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the 4th March, 1977 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
