#### EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

#### The East Sussex (Various Roads, Brighton) (Traffic Regulation) Orders 1977

Notice is hereby given that East Sussex County Council, with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport, have made two Orders under sections 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Orders is from 16th March 1977

(a) to make it unlawful for any vehicle other than a bus to wait at any bus stop in Langley Crescent, Woodingdean, between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. where the carriageway at that stop is marked (a) as a bus stop and (b) with a broad yellow line adjacent to the edge of the carriageway (the authorised markings). It should be noted (1) that the Order will apply only to those

bus stops which the Council marks with the authorised markings and (2) while the Order remains in force it will enable the Council at any time to lay or remove the authorised markings at or from any bus stop in Langley Crescent or to adjust the position in that road of the authorised markings, as traffic conditions require;

(b) to make it unlawful for any vehicle other than a bus, licensed hackney carriage or pedal cycle to proceed between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours of 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in the First Schedule to this notice;

(c) to make it unlawful for any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between the hours of 4 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive in the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Notice;

(d) to prohibit waiting at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Third Schedule to this notice;
